- Slovak Republic approved the establishment of the National Scholarship Programme for the support of mobility of students. PhD students, university teachers. researchers and artists in 2005
- The National Scholarship Programme of the Sloval Republic supports study, teaching, research/artistic stays at universities and research organisations. It supports two way mobility - international scholarship holders to Slovakia, as well as Slovak scholarship holders abroad. The Programme
- offers scholarships to cover living costs during the stay and travel allowances (all categories in case of scholarship holders PhD students in case of international scholarship holders).
- The Programme scholarship holders are scholarship holders of the Government of the Slovak Republic. The National Scholarship Programme is funded by the Ministry of Education. Science, Research and Sport of the Slovak Republic, and it is administered by SAIA, n. n.

Citizens of any country in the world can apply for a scholarship in the framework of the National Scholarship Programme of the Slovak Republic, except the citizens

#### Which country can you choose for your scholarship stay?

The Programme is not country limited. Scholarship stays can be carried out in any country in the world.

## What is the amount of the monthly scholarship?

The amount of the scholarship is set for each country separately. The scholarship shall cover average living costs in the respective country during the slay When setting the amount of the scholarship, only living costs are taken into consideration; it does not cover other costs, e.g. fuition lee. Amounts of monthly scholarships to the countries where scholarship stays have already been carried out is available at www.stlpendla.sk.

### What is the amount of a travel grant?

Travel grant is an allowance to cover travel costs (or their part) to and from a county of scholarsh p stay. Scholarship stay must last at least one month in case of PhU students, 3 months in case of postdoctoral researchers and in the case of students at least one academic term (semester/trimester). The amount of the travel grant is set by the Selection Committee taking into consideration up-to-date prices of transportation and budget possibilities of the Programme.
