What is BFA (Bachelor of Fine Arts)?

BFA or Bachelor of Fine Arts is an undergraduate degree course which deals with the study of Visual or Performing Arts. The course is sometimes also referred to as Bachelor of Visual Arts (BVA) in which the study of Visual Arts includes subjects such as painting, sculpture, photography, literature, animation, etc. On the other hand, the study of Performing Arts involves subjects such as dance, theatre and music. A Bachelor of Fine Arts degree often requires an area of specialisation to be chosen by the candidate as per his/her interest. Depending on the candidate's chosen specialisation, BFA is typically a three to four year duration course that can be pursued as a full-time, part-time, online or distance-learning programme.

BFA Eligibility Criteria

All candidates who have cleared Standard XII in any stream from a recognised board meet Bachelor of Fine Arts eligibility criteria. Although there is usually no other set criteria but some universities/colleges may also demand a minimum percentage (usually 50-60%) that candidates need to secure in Class 12th to get admission in BFA course. Apart from this, preference at the time of admission is sometimes given to candidates who have studied Arts/ Humanities in Class 12th and have some basic knowledge of the Fine Arts subject which they are looking to pursue.

Required Skillset for BFA

A Fine Arts course is usually pursued by students who have an artist hidden in them. However, candidates who have a creative bent of mind and a natural instinct towards visual or performing arts are a good fit for BFA course. Basic skills that candidates looking pursue a BFA course should have are:
