World class bodies like the US Department of State, British Council, UNFPA, UNICEF, UNESCO, Australian Government, and Bernard van Leer Foundation have been associated with the KISS. It is stressed that KISS has been addressing UN Sustainable Development Goals through its innovative teaching methods and has been accorded Special Consultative Status by the United Nations.
