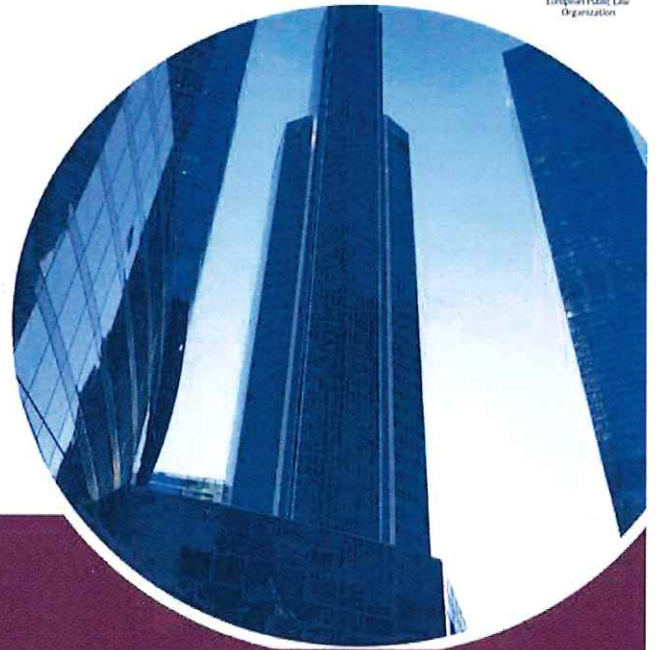

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- **Undergraduate degree** in law, governance or a relevant field of studies.
- **A Master's degree** in a relevant field is also acceptable.
- **Strong Profile students** from diverse academic backgrounds, including relevant experience and field dedication, are welcome to apply.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The LLM program is conducted entirely in English; non-native speakers must prove their proficiency as follows:

- TOEFL internet score of 90 or above
- IELTS 5.5
- Duolingo 95
- Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency, grade B or above
- Any other internationally recognized test with equivalent marks.
